- **Merit-Based Scholarship**

- **Government of Nepal (GON) Scholarship** GON provides 10% scholarship to students who have passed their SEE from government schools. Students should be listed in the merit list in the KMC scholarship examination, which will be conducted by KMSS.
- **KMSS Merit Scholarship:** KMSS provides scholarships to 10% of the total enrolled students who have passed their SEE from private schools. Students should be listed in the merit list for the KMSS Entrance Examination.

Note: Students must be enrolled at KMSS to be eligible for scholarships. Those seeking a need-based scholarship can apply in consultation with the academic coordinators. After a careful review of the student's financial condition, KMSS awards need-based scholarships to deserving candidates.

Accreditation & Grading Requirement

Kathmandu Model Secondary School (KMSS) is **accredited and certified by the National Examinations Board (NEB)**. The institution is authorized to offer academic programs in **Science, Management, Humanities, and Law**.

According to NEB regulations, students must complete a **minimum of 26.57 credits per academic year**. However, KMSS sets a higher standard, requiring students to earn **39.375 credits annually** to qualify for the board examinations.

Note: One credit hour is equivalent to 32 clock hours.
